



### Texas Representative Jasmine Crockett Attends Philadelphia Juneteenth Parade (6/16)





#### 27 Debate Watch Parties Across the Commonwealth (6/27)

On Thursday, June 27th, Pennsylvanians across the Commonwealth gathered at dozens of debate watch parties to cheer on President Biden as he took on Donald Trump. Many watch parties also featured special guests, such as Governor Josh Shapiro and Lieutenant Governor Austin Davis in Harrisburg, Senator Chris Coons in Philadelphia, Mayor Paige Cognetti in Scranton, and Allegheny County Executive Sara Innamorato in Pittsburgh.







#### Historic Weekend of Action after Debate (6/29 - 6/30)

Following the debate, the Biden-Harris campaign and PA Dems launched a weekend of action mobilization blitz with over 500 events, including canvasses, trainings, phone banks, and other engagements across the Commonwealth to energize voters and highlight the stakes of the 2024 election. The campaign engaged hundreds of volunteers and supporters at events across Pennsylvania the weekend and knocked on more than 10,000 doors. Notably, the team knocked doors and reached voters in all 66 wards in Philadelphia, which no campaign has done without a paid canvass in recent history.







We had some jeers, but we had plenty of cheers too. This is our first parade in the county and we have four more to go.






